



CATERING TRUCKS & OPERATORS PARKING GUIDELINES AND ENFORCEMENT

Parking in Mandeville Canyon and its public side streets is **Highly Restricted** due to our narrow roads and **NO Parking** throughout most our community. There is **NO PARKING allowed on Private Streets** without the permission of the homeowners.

If you come into this Canyon to offer your services, we highly recommend that you contact directly a homeowner who is under construction to request permissible times to park on their property to serve your clientele.

***Our community intends to uphold Municipal Code 80.73.
Violators will be cited with fines up to \$250.00 per violation.***

MUNICIPAL CODE 80.73: Applies to public streets.

1. Follow ALL Posted Signs and Curb Markings.
2. Do not park within 100 feet of any intersection. No person shall stop, stand, or park upon the street between the catering truck and the center of the street.
3. No person can stand in a portion of the street, which is between the catering truck and the center of the street.
4. You MUST provide in the immediate vicinity of the truck, a liter receptacle that is clearly marked with a sign requesting its use by patrons. Prior to leaving, you must pick up, remove and dispose of all trash or refuse which consists of materials dispensed from the catering truck.
5. You can ONLY stay at one residential location for 30-minutes and then you must move. Upon elapse of the 30-minute time period, you must move to a new location more than half a mile distant, as measured in a straight line, from the location where the vehicle was parked at the beginning of the 30-minute period.
If you refuse to leave when a homeowner requests you to do so, you will be cited!
